



April		Career Exposure Roundtables	In Person + Virtual	OppNet hosts several industry-specific roundtable discussions to increase OppNet students' awareness and exposure to various companies, fields, and positions. Roundtables consist of five to six professionals who work in the same field but in a variety of roles.
May 13-15		Summer Readiness Workshop	In Person	Volunteers work with high school students in small groups to discuss hypothetical workplace scenarios they might encounter during their upcoming summer internships and enrichment opportunities, sharing their favorite tips and best practices for professional communication and advice for internship success.
July	A	Summer Series Networking Event	In Person	This natural networking event is an opportunity for volunteers to get to know OppNet and our college students, helping them hone their communication and networking skills, introducing them to career paths, and providing insights into career industries.
July	A	Summer Series Career Panel	In Person	Panelists speak with OppNet college Fellows and share insights into their careers and professional journeys. Past panel themes have included imposter syndrome in the workplace, salary negotiations, personal brands, and more.
July		Career Exposure Trips	In Person	OppNet brings students on trips to various workplaces so that they can meet professionals, explore different career options, and experience a variety of professional environments. Career exposure trips are generally held in July as part of our Summer Institute orientation for our incoming 11th-grade students.
July	A	Data, Activated! Panel	Virtual	In this immersive virtual program, a cohort of OppNet Fellows harness various data sources to solve real-world problems, developing crucial data analysis skills. Panelists speak with this cohort about their experience with data and how data is used in their company and industry.
July		Summer Entrepreneurship Program	In Person + Virtual	During this four-week program, a cohort of OppNet Fellows learn the ins and outs of entrepreneurship, working in small groups to create their own business plans and pitches. Volunteers engage with students along the way during coaching workshops, providing valuable feedback on their business ideas, financial plans, marketing strategies, and more.


